- EECBG Programs will create 29 FTE jobs
- Programs will leverage up to \$750,000 in funds
- Projects will generate \$1.2M in energy savings per year
- Energy savings programs will reach 7% of City's residents
- Projects will reduce 7,700 tons of greenhouse gas emissions



The City of Fort Lauderdale was allocated \$2,036,400 from the Department of Energy under the Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) Program.

Carbon Solutions America (CSA) in collaboration with Environmental Dynamics and the Florida Center for Environmental Studies worked with the City and helped secure the grant allocation and developed a Greenhouse Gas Inventory and Sustainability Action Plan.

CSA established baseline measurements, identified target reduction and energy efficiency objectives, prioritized projects for funding, and provided the overall institutional framework to support the program for years to come by accessing additional funding opportunities.

The project was completed within an aggressive timeline of three months. The deliverables were highly appreciated by the City, Department of Energy and City's residents.
