The City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida selected CSA as its sustainability consultant for a third consecutive year to develop its greenhouse gas (GHG) inventory and to deliver training workshops to its sustainability department staff. CSA is currently working with the City's fleet and building managers to source energy use and emissions data for its 2012 GHG inventory. In the coming months, this data will be analyzed to develop Ft. Lauderdale's GHG footprint and evaluate the performance of its sustainability initiatives.

CSA is also delivering a series training workshops, educating the City's staff on the proper energy/emissions data collection procedures. In the process of training the staff, CSA is developing policies to address the intricacies and challenges of collecting Fort Lauderdale's data. In the upcoming workshop, CSA will be developing the sustainability department's staff's capacity to create a GHG inventory on their own and continue the monitoring of the City's sustainability performance into the future.
